Just Four Paws Rescue (JFPR) will only adopt dogs to applicants that agree to meet the following criteria:

- 1. The dog will be treated as a family member and will live inside the home with other family members. The dog will not be isolated and forced to live in the garage, basement, outdoor pen, backyard etc. The dog will be kept comfortable.
- 2. The dog will not be left tethered in a yard alone or tethered to be separate from others.
- 3. While most dogs are protective of their home and will alert to perceived threats, the dog's main purpose must not be for guarding purposes.
- 4. The dog will wear a tag to identify them and their adopters and will always be kept on their collar. This ensures the dog will be returned to you as quickly as possible.
- 5. JFPR will be notified if the dog is lost so we may participate in the search to find the dog.
- 6. The dog, if taken by a pound, shall not be left at the pound after notification that they have been found. If the dog is no longer wanted by the family, JFPR must be contacted and will immediately reclaim the dog.
- 7. The dog will receive regular vet care to help ensure a healthy life. The dog will be kept parasite free and will receive regular vaccinations. If the family has a financial constriction, then JFPR must be notified.
- 8. If a puppy is not spayed/neutered at the time of adoption, the dog will be spayed or neutered when he/she reaches the appropriate age, typically 6 months. JFPR will receive the spay/neuter certificate or the information of the clinic where the procedure was preformed.

- 9. The dog will be given the appropriate amount of exercise, play, stimulation, and socialization.
- 10. The dog will be fed good quality, nutritious food and always have access to water.
- 11. The dog will not be euthanized without consultation with JFPR except for reasons of untreatable/incurable illness. The dog will not be euthanized for behavioral issues without approval from JFPR.
- 12. The dog will not be crated for extended periods of time or for the purpose of punishment. Crating a dog should be only temporary or for reasons of transport or medical purposes only.
- 13. The dog will not be permanently re-homed to another person without the assistance of JFPR. We will help find a new, suitable home for the dog using the same adoption procedures we used to find him/her a home with the adopter.
- 14. At any time, the adopter can contact JFPR to return the dog for any reason. JFPR will take back possession of the dog as soon as a foster or another adoptive home can be found.
